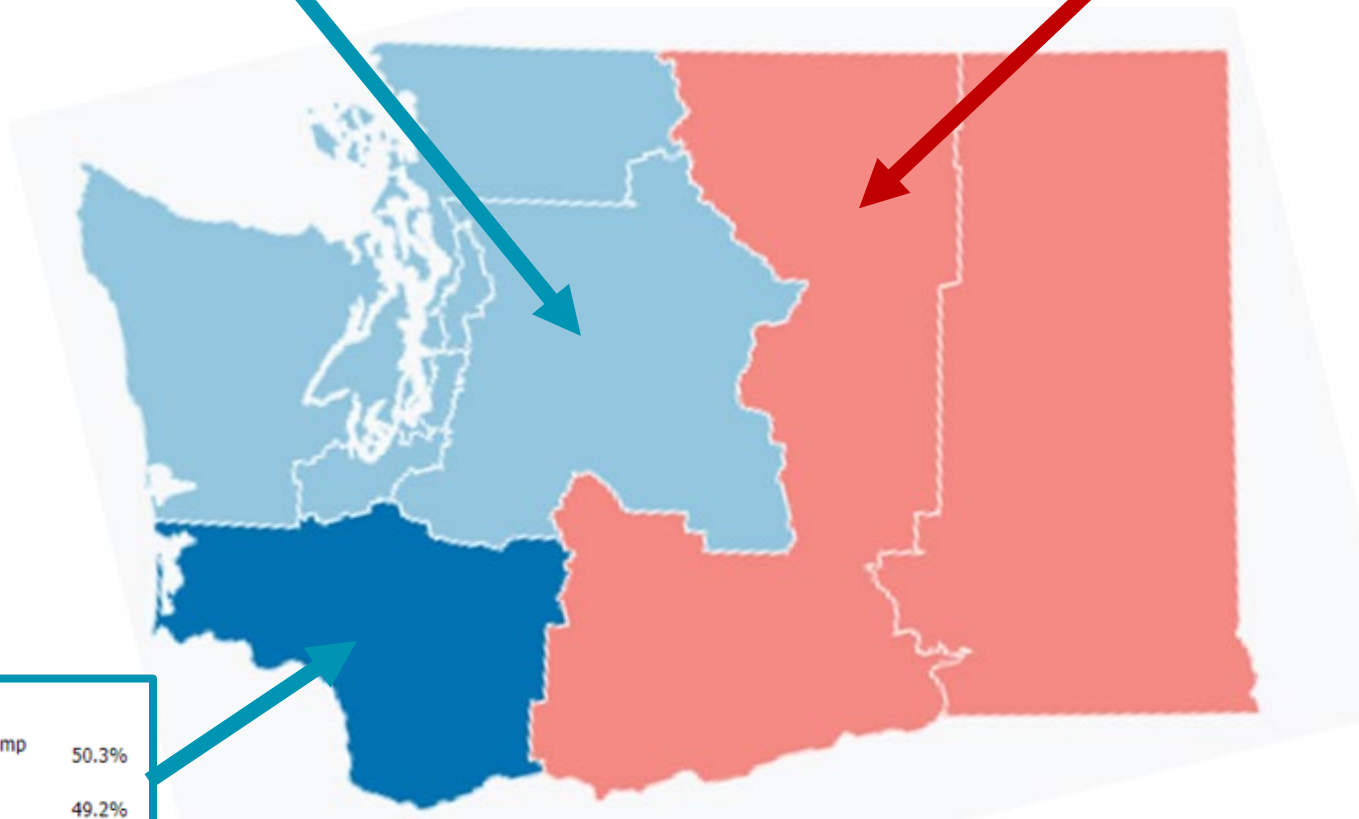

ANALYSIS OF RESULTS

- Unhappy Electorate Voted for Little Change
- GOP Issues Advantage Tempered by Abortion & Trump Fears
- Higher Republican Vote Total Did Not Produce a **Wave**
- Quality of Candidates Mattered
- Independents Broke Narrowly to Democrats
- Most Incumbents Won



MEANING FOR TRI-CITIES

- Delegation More Powerful Than Ever
- Don't Expect Much Sweeping Legislation
- More Congressional Investigations
- Focus will Shift to Executive Actions
- Could be a Few Bipartisan Opportunities
