



























































Permits Issued by Jurisdiction – 2012-2016





Economic Slowdown Ahead


GDP Growth Economic slowdown approaching

Tight Labor Market Lack of labor represents a macro risk




Consumer Confidence Continues Positive Run Near two-decade high but stock market declines took a toll at end of year




Rise in student and auto loans


Share of Young Adults Living with Parents Almost doubled


Total student loan balances by age group


Typical New Home Size Decline after market shift
